### Key Highlights and Events

**Keynote Sessions:** One student from each school is invited as keynote speaker/ guest speaker. You need to submit your full article in word format and PPT format to [seminars@icert.org.in](mailto:seminars@icert.org.in) before the last date. (Maximum one student each school). Only 20

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students/ schools will be selected for the final keynote session. All articles will be published in **Eduphoria-An International Multidisciplinary Magazine with International ISSN**. The research article (position paper) submitted must include the introduction, literature, methodology including data collection, analysis tools, finding, conclusion and suggestions.

**Fireside Chat:** One student from each school is invited as panellist for Fireside Chat. Registered school need to nominate one student and send the profile of the student, with a 2-3 minutes video including student's views on any sub-theme mentioned above, to [navneet@icert.org.in](mailto:navneet@icert.org.in) just after registration. Only 20 students will be selected for the Fireside Chat as final panellist. (One school can nominate only one student). Final sub-theme for each fireside chat will be allotted after final selection of students.

**(MUN General Assembly) Indo Global Student Legislature:** This event is designed to put students in the shoes of a person of influence in a Mock Legislature environment to train them to impact policy and culture of decision making at United Nations. It is a model representation how decisions are made at the UN. It is an engagement of students in learning activity that simulates the legislative process and excitement of parliamentary debate. One school must nominate 5 students for this event (One team=5 students). Concerned educator in-charge needs to send all delegates names to [navneet@icert.org.in](mailto:navneet@icert.org.in) just after registration. All coordination will be done with the teacher in-charge only. Team sub-themes will be allotted by the jury at a later stage after final selection of the students.

**Young Voices:** Nominations are invited from the schools for Young Voices, students can express their views, ideas, etc on the given sub-themes or any other theme related to main theme. One school can nominate a maximum one student only. A maximum 20 Students will be selected for young voices. School needs to send the names of delegates and their manuscript/ article to [navneet@icert.org.in](mailto:navneet@icert.org.in) just after registration. All manuscripts will be assessed by the panel of experts and only selected students will be invited for the Young Voices session.

**Panel Discussion:** One student from each school is invited as panellist for Panel Discussion. Registered school need to send the profile of nominated student and a 2-3 minutes video on any sub-theme including the views of student on the selected theme, to [navneet@icert.org.in](mailto:navneet@icert.org.in) just after registration. Only 20 students will be selected for the Panel Discussion as final panellist. (One school can nominate one student only).
