“United in action to rescue and achieve the SDGs for, with and by persons with disabilities”

The annual observance of the International Day of Persons with Disabilities (IDPD) on 3 December was proclaimed in 1992 by the United Nations General Assembly resolution 47/3. The observance of the Day aims to promote an understanding of disability issues and mobilize support for the dignity, rights and well-being of persons with disabilities. UN CRPD is working to change attitudes and approaches to persons with disabilities.
