- 3. Only selected research articles/ papers will be allowed for presentation.
- 4. Presentation must be in PPT format.
- 5. Only English language is accepted.
- 6. Presentation must be sent to <u>seminars@icert.org.in</u> for approval by Aug 05, 2023, last date for the submission of full papers for publication is Aug 31, 2023.
